Proposed changes to the academic integrity policy, this has already passed through the faculty governance once, they wanted to hear student thoughts before going in for final approval.

On top of our current academic integrity policy they are adding a method students can use to appeal a faculty member's allegation. Students must complete a student concern form within 10 days from sanction filing which will be reviewed by persons not involved in the allegation/class. If the violation is found to have indeed occurred, then we will enter it in the database and refer to the syllabus for further outcomes. A second violation will be entered in the database, referred to the syllabus, and the student will be required to schedule an Academic Integrity Training Session. On a third violation the Academic Integrity Committee will recommend to the VPAA for possible suspension.

An Academic Integrity Training session entails an ethics lesson and details as to exactly what a violation is and how to avoid them in the future. Contact Tim or Bob if you're interested in attending a session without any academic integrity violations.
