SCTCC will be offering courses for English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) starting fall 2017. The courses offered will include 3 writing courses, 3 reading courses, and 3 speaking and listening courses.

SCTCC's ESOL courses are designed for students whose first language is not English, and who wish to improve their general and academic English.

Student placement into one of the 3 courses will be determined by the ESL Reading Accuplacer test score, an intake interview, and an optional writing sample.

## ESOL Pathway

SCTCC's ESOL courses consist of 3 levels. Not all students will need to take all three levels. Each level will include a reading course, a writing course and a speaking and listening course.

### Level 1: Foundations

This level includes foundational courses in writing, reading and speaking and listening. Students will learn basic communication skills that can be applied in general settings.

### Level 2: Academic Purposes

This level includes courses in writing, reading, and speaking and listening that introduce students to academic and professional communications.

### Level 3: College Purposes

This level includes courses in writing, reading, and listening and speaking that prepare students for the high communication demands found in college level courses.
